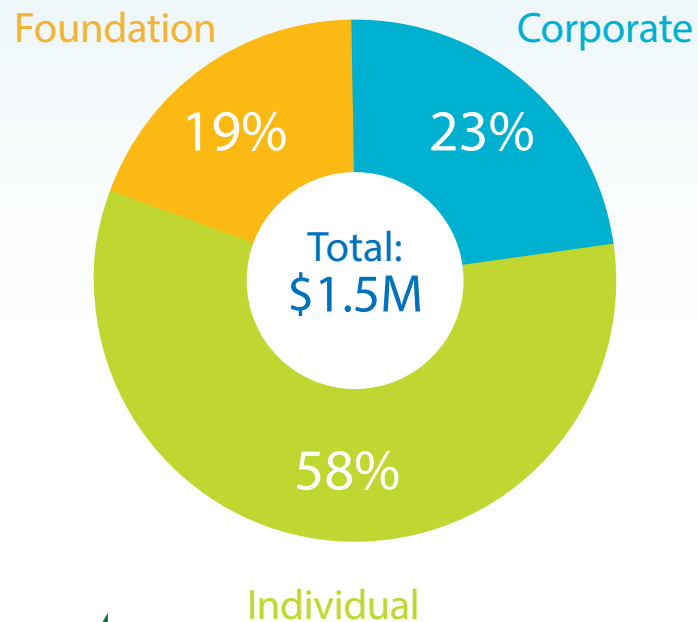


Our Fundraising Goal
